**ORDINANCE NO. 698**

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS AND AMENDING SECTION 9-112 OF THE GLEN ELDER CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the City of Glen Elder has adopted Charter Ordinance No. 6 and Charter Ordinance No. 2002 #1 exempting it from K.S.A. 12-4112 and pursuant thereto the City of Glen Elder adopted subsequent ordinances establishing and increasing court costs for each person found guilty of a violation of the ordinances of the City of Glen Elder. Upon review, the Governing Body has determined that an increase in the court costs is necessary.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS:

**Section 1:** Section 9-112 of the Glen Elder City Code is hereby amended and restated as follows:


- (a) Every person found guilty of a violation of an ordinance of the city shall be assessed court costs, payable to the municipal court of the city for the administration of justice, in the amount of \$100.00 per case.
- (b) In addition to court costs assessed by subsection (a), the clerk of the municipal court is further directed to collect and remit to appropriate agencies of the State of Kansas, as required by law, such additional amounts as may be required by law.

**Section 2:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
