

ORDINANCE NO. 751

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS; REPEALING ALL PRIOR WAGE ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, has considered and wishes to establish the following salaries and hourly wages for all full-time and part-time employees of the City of Glen Elder.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERENING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Light/Water/Sewer Superintendent shall receive for his/her services the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 2. The Retiring Light/Water/Sewer Superintendent shall receive for his/her services the sum of Twenty-three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$23.50) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 3. The Water/Sewer Superintendent shall receive for his/her services the sum of Eighteen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$18.50) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 4. The Park/Cemetery Superintendent shall receive for his/her services the sum of Seventeen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$17.50) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall receive for his/her services the sum of Twenty-one Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$21.50) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 6. The Part-Time Office Assistant shall receive for his/her services the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 7. The Part-Time Maintenance Employee shall receive for his/her services the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 8. The City Treasurer shall receive for his/her services the sum of One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$160.00) per month.

SECTION 9. The Municipal Judge shall receive for his/her services the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per year.

SECTION 10. The Code Enforcement Officer shall receive for his/her services the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per month. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 11. The Fire Chief shall receive the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per year; the Assistant Fire Chief shall receive the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per year; the Fire Department Secretary/Treasurer shall receive the sum of Eighty Dollars (\$80.00) per year. All firemen shall receive for their services the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per meeting attended and the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per fire run attended.

SECTION 12. The Part-Time Summer Employee shall receive for his/her services the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 12. The City Pool Manager shall receive for his/her services the sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$3,200.00) per year. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 13. The City Pool Lifeguards shall receive for their services the following hourly wage, with the hours of work fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder:

- 1st Year Lifeguard: \$10.00 per hour
- 2nd Year with a good evaluation: \$10.25 per hour
- 3rd Year with a good evaluation: \$10.50 per hour
- 4th Year with a good evaluation: \$10.75 per hour
- Head Lifeguard with WSI: \$11.00 per hour

SECTION 14. The Mayor shall receive for his/her services the sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per meeting.

SECTION 15. Each council member shall receive for his/her services the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per meeting.

SECTION 16. The City Attorney's pay shall be established by contract between the attorney and the City.

SECTION 17. Ordinance Numbered 742 and all prior wage ordinances are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect beginning with the January 1, 2023 earnings and will be in full force.
