**Glen Elder City Council Special Minutes  
February 9, 2026**

The Glen Elder City Council met in special session on Monday night at 6:00 p.m., February 9, 2026, at City Hall with Mayor Sheila Paxson presiding and council members: Lori Augustine, Landen Cleveland, Kevin Noller, and Angie Behymer present. Also, in attendance Tyron Gruwell, Chelsa Anderson, Devon Housh, and Jerri Senger.

**Multi-Sport Court Renovation Bids**

Tyron Gruwell, representing SMC Concrete and Construction, presented the council with the requested revised bids. The bids, the colored concrete, and a rubberized top coating were all discussed. The council liked the blue and green rubberized top coating and asked Tyron to revise the bids again. Meanwhile, Devon informed the council the survey will be done this week and will cost approximately \$1,200.00. Devon presented the council with basketball goal choices and pickleball net options. The council liked the Goalrilla goals with a perforated metal backboard. It was decided a permanent pickleball net and portable one would be purchased. The portable net will be stored at the city shop, but available for use. The council calculated the total cost for lights, poles, lighting supplies, nets, goals, and the land survey to cost approximately \$23,809.00.

Chelsa informed the council the Patterson Family Grant is open with a submission deadline of February 18<sup>th</sup>. She also mentioned CVA and Land O'Lakes' donations are coming and should be about \$3,000.00.

Due to the late hour, Tyron was unable to revise the bids without contacting his vendors. At 7:15 p.m. Landen made a motion to continue the meeting tomorrow, February 11, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. Angie seconded the motion and the vote carried with four ayes.

February 10, 2026

Mayor Paxson reopened the special meeting at 1:00 p.m. at City Hall with Lori Augustine, Landen Cleveland, Kevin Noller, Angie Behymer, Devon Housh, and Jerri Senger present.

The council reviewed the revised bid from SMC. Devon Housh suggested the city crew build the shelter for a total material cost of \$5,808.00. Angie made a motion to accept SMC's court renovation bid for \$152,193.62 and have the city crew build the shelter. Lori seconded the motion and the vote carried with four ayes.

With no other business, Landen made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion and with four council members voting aye, the meeting was adjourned at 1:05 p.m.
