

**ORDINANCE NO. 754**

AN ORDINANCE regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas; incorporating by reference the “Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities”, 39<sup>th</sup> Edition of 2023, with certain omissions, changes and additional provisions; providing certain penalties and repealing Ordinance No. 742#2.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That Section 11-101, 11-102, and 11-103 of the Glen Elder City Code are hereby amended by adding the following sections which shall read as follow:

- a. 11-101: Incorporating Uniform Public Offense Code: There is hereby incorporated by reference for purposes of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, that certain code known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code”, 2023 39<sup>th</sup> Edition, (“UPOC”)” prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts of portions as are hereby omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three (3) copies of said UPOC shall be marked or stamped ‘Official Copy’, as adopted by Ordinance No. 754, with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omissions or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and filed with the City Clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative department of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of the UPOC, similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.
- b. 11-102 Same; Omissions. The Following sections are omitted from UPOC: Article 10, Section 10.13 (barbed wire).
- c. 11-103 Same; Amendments. The Following sections are amended to allow bow and arrow target practice, only upon a private property owner’s property, with a bona fide target practice area. Article 10, Sections 10.6, 10.7 and 10.8. All other bow and arrow discharging within the city limits is prohibited.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Ordinance number 742#2 is repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
