**ORDINANCE NO. 713**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CITY OF GLEN ELDER PARK AND CEMETERY REGULATIONS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

**Section 1.** Section 12-102 of the Glen Elder City Code is hereby amended and restated as follows:

12-102. CITY LAWS EXTENDED TO PARK. The laws of the city shall extend to and cover all city parks with the City of Glen Elder, including the City of Glen Elder baseball field and the Pioneer Cemetery.

**Section 2.** Section 12-113 is hereby added to the Glen Elder City Code:

12-113. DOGS. Any person bringing a dog to any park must have the dog under his/her command and control at all times, either by leash or voice command. Persons in charge of the dog shall be equipped to clean up after their dog and must clean up when the dog's actions so require.

**Section 3.** Section 12-114 is hereby added to the Glen Elder City Code:

12-114. PENALTIES. Any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction, be punished by fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days, or, by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. Each day any violation of this chapter continues shall constitute a separate offense.

**Section 4.** Section 12-204 is hereby added to the Glen Elder City Code:

12-204. DOGS. Any person bringing a dog to Glenwood Cemetery must have the dog under his/her command and control at all times, either by leash or voice command. Persons in charge of the dog shall be equipped to clean up after their dog and must clean up when the dog's actions so require.

**Section 5.** Section 12-205 is hereby added to the Glen Elder City Code:

12-205. PENALTIES. Any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction, be punished by fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days, or, by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court. Each day any violation of this chapter continues shall constitute a separate offense.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and one publication in the official newspaper.
