**ORDINANCE NO. 726**

AN ORDINANCE regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas; incorporating by reference the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities”, Edition of 2019, with certain omissions, changes and additional provisions; providing certain penalties and repealing Ordinance No. 715.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That Section 14-101 of the Glen Elder City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. Incorporating Standard Traffic Ordinance.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2019, (“STO”)” prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as hereinafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. Not less than three (3) copies of the Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped ‘Official Copy’ as adopted by Ordinance No. 726, with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted, deleted, modified or changed clearly marked to show any such omissions, deletion, modification or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this incorporating ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative department of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of the Standard Traffic Ordinance, similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

b. Traffic Regulations on private property.

Whenever the person in possession or control of any private property used by the public for purposes of vehicular traffic by permission of the owner shall cause to be posted at each entrance thereto a permanently lettered clearly legible sign with the following or a substantially similar legend:

TRAFFIC REGULATION OF THE CITY OF Glen Elder  
ENFORCED ON THIS PROPERTY, SPEED LIMIT  
12 M.P.H. (OR AS POSTED.)

Then such private property shall thereafter be deemed to be regulated by all traffic regulations of the city as provided by law.

c. Skateboarding restrictions.

Sec. 131b. No skateboarding is permitted in that part of the City of Glen Elder bounded by Hobart, Railroad, College and Allen Streets.

SECTION 2. Deletion of Certain Sections.


Sec. 114.1 of said Standard Traffic Ordinance relating to Unlawful Operation of All-Terrain Vehicle, 114.2 of said Standard Traffic Ordinance relating to Unlawful Operation of a Micro Utility Truck, 114.4 of said Standard Traffic Ordinance relating to Unlawful Operation of a Golf Cart, and 114.5 of said Standard Traffic Ordinance relating to Unlawful Operation of Work-Site Utility Vehicle are hereby declared to be and is omitted and deleted. Regulation of All-Terrain Vehicles, Micro Utility Truck, Work-Site Utility Vehicle, and Golf Cart will be governed by Ordinance No. 718.

SECTION 3. REPEAL. Ordinance number 715 is repealed.



SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
