**ORDINANCE NO. 714**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING OF CAMPERS AND TRAILERS ON CITY STREETS IN THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS.

**Section 1.** Section 14-213 of the Glen Elder City Code is hereby amended and restated as follows:

14-213. RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to park any recreational vehicle, camper, trailer, travel trailer, boat trailer, house trailer, pole trailer, semi trailer, special mobile equipment or motor home on any city street between October 1 and April 1.
- (b) For the period from April 1 to September 30, it shall be unlawful to park any recreational vehicle, camper, trailer, travel trailer, boat trailer, house trailer, pole trailer, semi trailer, special mobile equipment or motor home on any city street for a period longer than ten (10) days.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and one publication in the official newspaper.
