ORDINANCE NO. 763

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATES CHARGED FOR USE OF THE WATER UTILITY SYSTEM BY THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER; AMENDING SECTION 15-221 OF THE GLEN ELDER CITY CODE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 747.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, has considered and deemed it advisable to increase rates for water usage by water consumers from the City's water utility system, as set out hereinafter.

SECTION 2. Section 15-221 of the Glen Elder City Code is hereby amended as follows:

15-221 RATES. The rates per month for use of water from the City's water utility system shall be as follows:

- a) \$20.00 minimum charge; and
- b) all water used shall be charged at the rate of \$3.70 per one thousand gallons of usage.

SECTION 3. When two or more dwelling units such as duplexes, apartments, trailer homes, recreational vehicle parks, and campgrounds having separate kitchen facilities and/or separate electrical meters, are served through one water meter, this schedule is applied by multiplying the monthly minimum charge by the number of dwelling units served through the meter. Multiple dwelling units that are individually billed for electricity and sewer, shall also be charged the water minimum to each individual unit.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 747 is hereby repealed as of the effective date set forth below.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective with the January 19, 2025 meter readings/billing and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
