### CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 25-2120 RELATING TO THE START DATE OF A REGULAR TERM OF OFFICE FOR A CITY OFFICER, AMENDING SECTION 4 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE 9.

Whereas, the Governing Body believes it to be in the best interest of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, to exempt itself from K.S.A. 25-2120.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS:

**Section 1.** Section 4 of Charter Ordinance 9 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. City officers shall take office on the first Monday in December, after the November general election.

**Section 2:** This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

**Section 3:** This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, and signed by the Mayor this 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2019.
