**ORDINANCE NO. 720**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARIES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS; AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, & 4 OF ORDINANCE 710, AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ORDINANCE 634, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 697.

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder, Kansas, has considered and deemed it advisable to increase salaries of the select full-time and part-time employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** Sections 1, 2, 3, & 4 of Ordinance 710 shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Light/Water/Sewer Superintendent shall receive for his services the sum of Nineteen Dollars (\$19.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 2. The City Maintenance Employee shall receive for his services the sum of Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 3. The Park/Cemetery Superintendent shall receive for his services the sum of Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall receive for her services the sum of Seventeen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$17.50) per hour. The hours of work for said employee shall be fixed by the Governing Body of the City of Glen Elder.

**SECTION 2.** Section 12 of Ordinance 634 shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 12. The Part-time Office Assistant shall receive for her services the wage of Nine Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$9.50) per hour.

**SECTION 3.** Ordinance 697 is repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning with the January 1, 2019 earnings and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
