ORDINANCE # 741

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1%) WITHIN THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALL MONEY COLLECTED ALLOCATED FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND OTHER GENERAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS OF THE CITY, EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GLEN ELDER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 2nd day of November, 2021, the levying of retailers' sales tax in the City of Glen Elder, for the purpose of all money collected allocated for capital improvements projects and other general infrastructure improvement projects of the City, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, as amendments thereto, there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1%) to take effect on the 1st day of April, 2022.

SECTION 2: Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce, and collect such tax.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be published in the official city newspaper, and a copy duly certified and submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
